CSCB Scholarships Information

The scholarship application are being accepted between 7 June and 30 July 2021 at 2 pm ET!

The CSCB National Scholarship, the CSCB Guy Graveline Scholarship, and the scholarship for undergraduate students are national scholarships funded and administered by the Canadian Society of Customs Brokers.

The CSCB National and the CSCB Guy Graveline scholarships are worth CDN \$3,500 each and will be awarded to two students on the basis of academic results and other achievements, experiences and personal goals. Students entering any accredited college or university program are eligible to apply.

A third scholarship of \$3500 will be awarded to a student returning to any accredited Canadian college or university program for their second, third or fourth year, based on academic performance as well as other achievements, experiences and personal goals. Once again, the student must be a child, stepchild, grandchild or person under the legal guardianship of an individual who is employed with a CSCB member firm. In fact, for all three scholarships, you may qualify if you are employed by a CSCB member firm and considering opportunities for continuing your own education at college or university.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the CSCB Scholarships, the applicant must:

Undergraduate Scholarship

Be a child, stepchild, grandchild, or under the legal guardianship of an individual who is employed with a [CSCB member firm](#), or must be an individual employed with a CSCB member firm.

Applicant outside Quebec: must be a student in his or her final year or a recent graduate (within the previous 12 months) of Canadian secondary school who has official acceptance by an accredited university or college in Canada and must be entering the first year of a post-secondary program.

Applicant: must be a student continuing their post- secondary studies at an accredited university or college in Canada and must be entering a subsequent year of study beyond year one.

Applicant from Quebec: must be a CEGEP student who has successfully completed (within the previous 12 months) a minimum of 12 “General” or “pre-university” courses in Canada and is continuing their post-secondary studies at either an accredited university or college in Canada, other than a CEGEP.

Have a minimum 75% average in top five Grade 12 or CEGEP courses.

Consideration given to community involvement, participation in extracurricular activities, special interests and achievements, leadership qualities, and candidate’s short and long term goals.

To be assessed from the previous year’s official school transcript.

Previous CSCB scholarship winners are not eligible to apply.

Consideration given to other achievements, experiences and personal goals.

Process

To be considered, an eligible applicant’s package must contain:

- a completed application form (**application deadline is 30 July 2021 at 2 pm ET**)
- the candidate’s most recent official secondary school, CEGEP, or post-secondary school transcript. Should the applicant receive a subsequent transcript after the initial submission, it is recommended that this be forwarded to the CSCB National Office by [email](#), by 9 August 2021;
- at least one letter of reference;
- a copy of the candidate’s letter or offer of acceptance from an accredited post-secondary institution; and
- a letter of application (500 word maximum) written by the candidate.

Completed applications must be submitted no later than **30 July 2021 at 2 p.m. ET**. Any applications not containing the required documentation or received after the deadline will not be considered.

All applicants will receive from the CSCB a letter acknowledging receipt of the application package. The successful candidate will be notified no later than 20 August 2021. The committee’s decision will be final and not subject to appeal.
