Dear Mrs. West:

The Department of Finance is currently reviewing a request for the removal of customs duties on imports of metal heads used in the manufacture or production of certain yard and percussion hand tools. The specific items for which duty relief has been requested, along with the tariff item numbers under with they are classified and their rates of customs duty under the Most-Favoured-Nation (MFN) Tariff, are included in the following table.

Tariff Item No.	Description of Item for which Duty Relief Requested	MFN Tariff
8201.10.00	Heads for use in the manufacture or production of spades and shovels	5.0%
8201.30.90	Heads for use in the manufacture or production of mattocks, picks, hoes and rakes	6.0%
8201.40.90	Heads for use in the manufacture or production of axes, bill hooks and similar hewing tools	6.0%
8201.90.90	Heads for use in the manufacture or production of other hand tools of a kind used in agriculture, horticulture or forestry	6.5%
8205.20.90	Heads for use in the manufacture or production of hammers and sledge hammers	7.0%
8205.59.90	Heads for use in the manufacture or production of other hand tools	6.5%

The applicant claims there is no production in Canada of forged heads of certain yard and percussion hand tools, and that the cost of non-forged heads of these tools produced in Canada is not competitive, and that tariff relief would thus enhance its competitiveness in domestic and international markets.
