The highway carrier can get the Matched and Not Matched notices if they submit a cargo that indicates it is consolidated. The scenario in the presentation shows non-consolidated highway cargo in which case they don't receive the Matched/Not Matched. Non-consolidated cargo starts at Cargo Complete.
