1 Introduction

1.1 Background

The Single Window Initiative (SWI) was identified as one of 32 joint priorities within the Perimeter Security and Economic Competitiveness Action Plan (hereinafter the “*Action Plan*”) announced on December 7, 2011, to facilitate trade chain partners (TCPs) (i.e. importers and brokers) and align regulatory approaches to protect health, safety and the environment while supporting growth. The Action Plan committed the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) and U.S. Customs and Border Protection (USCBP) to provide TCPs with a single window in which they can electronically submit all information required to comply with government import regulations, resulting in a more efficient border process.

Importers/Brokers (IBs) are no longer be required to send duplicated information via different delivery mechanisms to multiple agencies in order to meet regulatory requirements. The Integrated Import Declaration (IID) includes all CBSA required data as well as all data essential for Participating Government Departments and Agencies (PGAs) to make border-related decisions and acts as the foundation for the modernization of government business processes by eliminating the requirement for presentation of paper documents at the border.

1.2 Document Purpose

The main vehicle for communicating the transaction details and usage of the IID has been the SWI Electronic Commerce Requirements Document (ECCRD), which has been published in successive versions since the spring of 2013. The latest version of the SWI ECCRD is v5.0, published November 2022.

This Addendum outlines the proposed changes to be applied to version 5.0 of the SWI ECCRD. The complete set of requirements for the IID is now:

- The SWI ECCRD v5.0 from April 2022
- ECCRD Addendum v1.7 (This document)
- The Participants Requirements Document (PRD) Image Functionality v1.5 from September 2017.
- CBSA Bulletin **TCC22-119** (sent on December 13, 2022)
- CBSA Bulletin **TCC23-004** (sent on January 27, 2023)
- CBSA Bulletin **TCC24-107** (sent November 5, 2024)
- CBSA Bulletin **TCC25-0030** (sent February 27, 2025)

Next SWI ECCRD Publication

The next full SWI ECCRD publication (version 5.1) will be available following implementation of the changes listed within this addendum.

2.1 Appendix A: IID EDIFACT Inbound MIG

The following is a list of changes to the Message Implementation Guide (MIG):

1) UNH - Message Header (page 34):

In order to mitigate the impact on Trade Chain Partners, CBSA plans to implement the changes listed within this addendum with IID version 5.01. Once the changes are available in CBSA's Production environment, clients may continue submitting version 4.02 IIDs for approximately 6 months. This window will provide clients time to make the applicable code changes and the ability to switch to version 5.01 when ready.

Please note, IID version code 4.02 will remain the default IID version when these Addendum changes are made available in production:

2.3 Environment and Climate Change Canada

2.3.1 Waste Reduction & Management Division

Description of change:

1) Added functionality to enable brokers/importers to electronically submit digital images for document types 8000 (Movement Document) and 8001 (HW/HRM Permit) instead of a paper copy being provided to Border Services Officers at time of import.

2) As a result of an extensive review of ECCC's Hazardous Waste Program, ECCC has determined that the current matching rules for this program (movement of waste document (code 8000) and the movement of waste permit (code 8001) may not provide a fulsome approach to identifying shipments that contain hazardous waste and hazardous recyclable materials. As such, ECCC is requesting that a new matching rule be added to this program to match on HS code. If the IID matches on the HS code, all normal WRMD data element rules should be applied. However, If the shipment is not regulated by the WRMD program, clients will be required to provide a new exception code which omits the normal WRMD rules.

The new HS matching rules will take effect only when IID version code 4.02 rules have been sunset.

- Country of Source will be removed from the data requirements at SG104/SG118.
- LPCO Country of Origin will be added at SG12/SG124 to capture the species origin as listed on the CITES and/or WAPPRIITA LPCO.

2.6 Health Canada

Description of change: CBSA and Health Canada are collaborating to simplify the matching criteria for each Health Canada program. The new matching criteria will be set to match **only on HS code**. 2.6.4 Controlled Drugs/Substances and Cannabis (formerly Office of Controlled Substances)

Description of change: Health Canada has advised the Canada Border Services Agency that Cannabis is now a separate business line within their Directorate. As a result, the following changes are required to the Controlled Drugs and Substances Program.

1) Rename the title of the program B6.7 from Office of Controlled Substances to ‘Controlled Drugs/Substances and Cannabis’

2) Update the HC program descriptions (B6.1.1, B6.2.1, B6.3.1, B6.4.1, B6.5.1, B6.6.1, B6.7.1, B6.8.1, B6.9.1, B6.10.1, B6.11.1, and B6.12.1) in the PGA appendix to read:

“The CBSA assists Health Canada in administering the following legislation at the border: the *Cannabis Act*, *Canada Consumer Product Safety Act*, the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act*, the *Food and Drugs Act*, the *Hazardous Products Act*, the *Radiation Emitting Devices Act*, the *Pest Control Products Act*, as well as regulations made thereunder.

In addition to the above, update the program description (B6.7.1) to read:

“These activities apply to all controlled drugs and substances, cannabis and hemp regulated under the *Cannabis Act* and the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act*.”

3) Under the ‘Canadian Product Category’, ‘Medical Marihuana’ (HC18) will be renamed ‘Cannabis’.

4) LPCO document type 5017 (formerly Marihuana for Medical Purposes Regulations Producer Licence) will be renamed Cannabis Import Permit.

5) LPCO document type 5018 (formerly Import Permit) will be renamed OCS Import Permit.

6) LPCO document type 5041 (formerly Industrial Hemp Licence) will be renamed Hemp Import Permit.

7) LPCO document type 5043 (formerly Research Licence) will be renamed Hemp Licence Holder #.

8) Image URN is to be made mandatory (from optional) for LPCO document types: 5017 (Cannabis Import Permit), 5018 (OCS Import Permit), 5040 (Class A Precursor Licence) and 5041 (Hemp Import Permit). If the associated image is missing, the transaction will receive an IID reject for a missing LPCO image.

9) Under ‘Intended Use’ category, ‘Agricultural Use’ (HC16) will be renamed ‘Various Uses (import from approved cultivar only)’.

10) Under ‘Intended Use’ category, ‘Processing’ (HC17) will be removed.

11) Combination of Intended Use code HC28 (Resale) and Product Category code HC18 (Medical Marihuana) will be removed.

2.6.6 Pesticides (Pest Management Regulatory Agency)

Description of change: In September 2017, the *Pest Control Products Regulations* (PCPR) were amended and as a result of these amendments, importers of pest control products are now required to declare products that have been treated with a pest control product. Treated seeds are considered to be pest control products under the *Pest Control Products Act* (PCPA). The following is a list of changes which will be implemented to capture the active ingredient details of the pest control product used to treat seed products:

- Mandatory product category group/product category code to identify if seeds are treated with a pest control product
- Mandatory Active Ingredient code (for treated seed products) will be captured at SG117.IMD with qualifier '40' (Active Substance), along with applicable application rate for the chemical
- Conditional Requirement to provide LPCO Document type 5027 and an image attachment
- Mandatory Quantity (in KGs) of treated seeds
- Treated seed data requirements apply to the following HS code categories:

2.7 Natural Resources Canada

2.7.1 Explosives Program

Description of Change: Currently, trade chain partners (TCPs) are required to submit the name of the licence holder to import Explosives using the Single Window Integrated Import Declaration (IID). When the name of the licence holder contains special characters (e.g. French accents) the system cannot process them and the entry is rejected. As a result, a new Company ID field will be added for the Explosives program. When the Client ID is found on the permit, it must be reported on the IID to prevent potential issues with the party name field. Validation of the Company ID will take higher precedence over the party name and prevent unnecessary rejects.

Note: This change will be implemented in a future release, separate from the changes on IID version code 5.01. However, the Company ID field should be coded and transmitted on the IID in advance to enable CBSA and NRCan to proceed with future system changes. Validation will remain on the party name field until further notice. Reject notices will not be issued for missing Company ID in the interim.

2.9.2 Vehicles Program - FMVSS Standard / FMVSS Case by Case

Description of change: Changes to the current Transport Canada Motor Vehicle Safety Regulations (MVS), section 12, came into effect February 20, 2020 that allows for the importation of certain United States, Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS) compliant, used vehicles, from Mexico under specific conditions, as per the former NAFTA (now Canada-United States-Mexico Agreement (CUSMA)) agreement. Only used vehicles of the following regulated classes, being imported from Mexico will be admissible to Canada as per the terms of the agreement; Passenger Car, Multi-Purpose Passenger Vehicle (MPV), Truck and Bus.

As such, system rules will be made to ensure that the SWI IID can accommodate those used vehicles that may be imported from Mexico.
